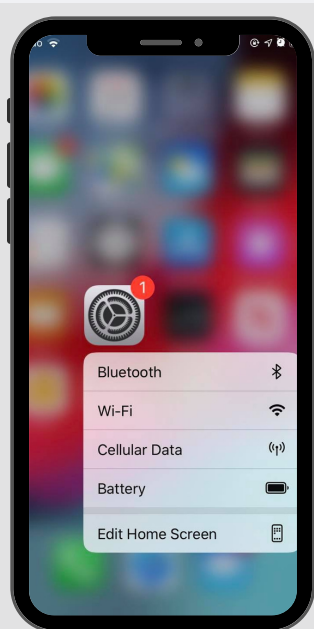


# STEPS TO SCREEN RECORD ON AN IPHONE

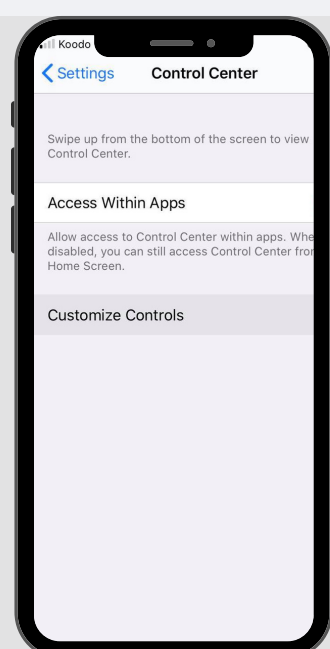
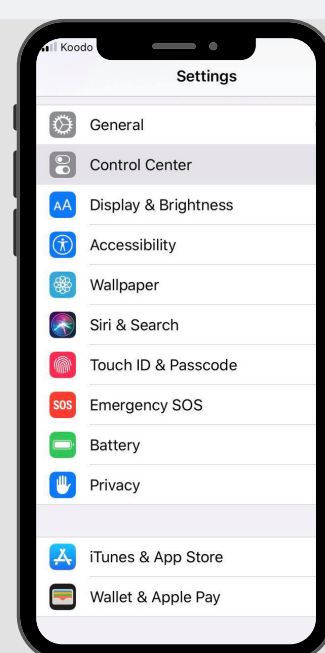


## GO INTO SETTINGS

Find "Settings" in the dashboard and click it to open.

## CLICK CONTROL CENTER

Scroll down in settings and click on "Control Center"

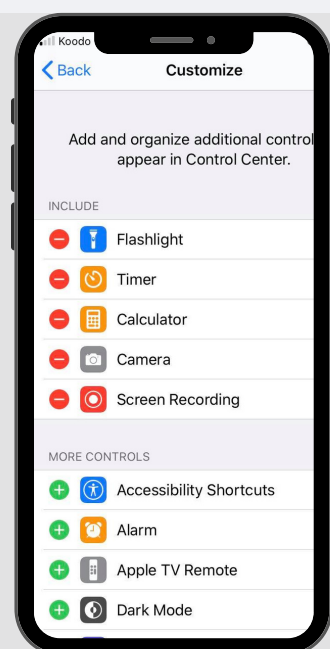
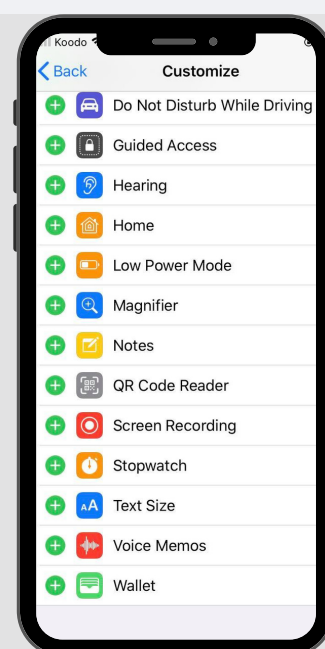


## CLICK CUSTOMIZE CONTROLS

Once you open the control center click on Customize Controls

## CLICK SCREEN RECORDING

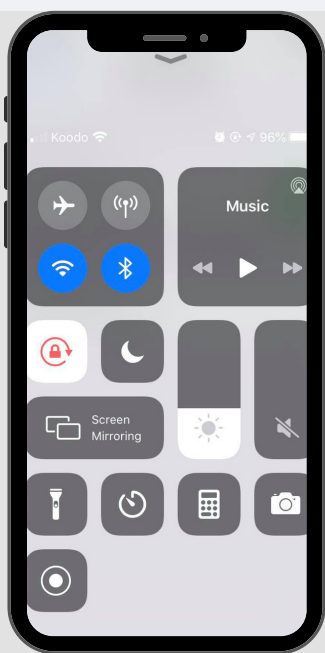
Click on the + sign next to screen recording to enable screen recording in the control center. NOTE: it will disappear from the menu but will reappear under the 'include' section



## SCREEN RECORDING IS ENABLED

You'll see that you have enabled screen recording in the "Include" section.

# STEPS TO SCREEN RECORD ON AN IPHONE (CONTINUED)

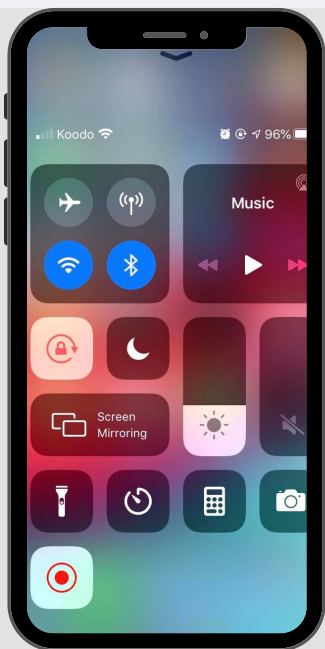


## OPEN UP YOUR CONTROL CENTER AND HOLD RECORDING BUTTON

Different phones have different ways that they view their control center. You may have to swipe up, swipe down, or swipe to the side. You'll notice the circular screen recording button in the bottom left of this picture. Hold this down.

## MAKE SURE YOUR MICROPHONE IS TURNED ON

Once you hold down the screen recording button in control center, a pop-up will appear. Turn the "Microphone On" on your iPhone.

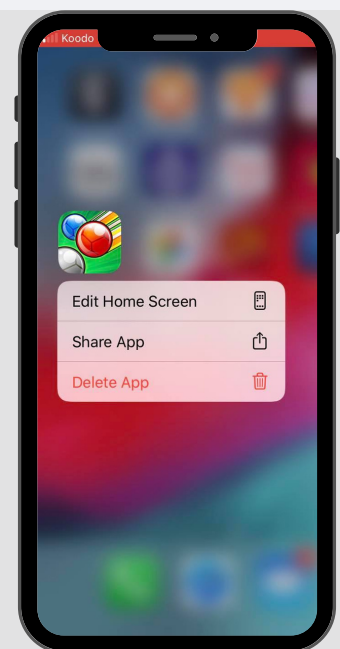


## SCREEN RECORDING HAS STARTED

When the button is red it means that the screen recording has officially started. You can now exit the control center.

## OPEN THE BOCCIA BATTLE APP

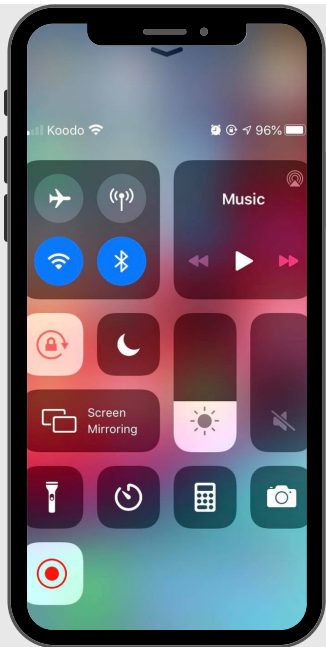
Open the Boccia Battle App that you've already downloaded from the App Store to start playing 1 vs. 1 against a friend.



## PLAY A GAME AGAINST YOUR OPPONENT

Now you can proceed to play the game against your opponent. Passwords will be given in your Zoom breakout rooms. Feel free to add commentary as you wish. Remember: everything is still being recorded on your phone!

# STEPS TO SCREEN RECORD ON AN IPHONE (CONTINUED)



## OPEN THE CONTROL CENTER TO STOP RECORDING

As I mentioned before, different phones have different ways that they view their control center. You may have to swipe up, swipe down, or swipe to the side. You'll notice the circular screen recording button in the bottom left of this picture is still red because you are currently recording.

## TURN OFF SCREEN RECORDING

Tap the red screen recording button to stop the recording. A tab will open up on your phone that explains: "Screen Recording video saved to Photos". Now you know where to find the screen recording you just took.
