### DEFINITIONS

1. The following terms have these meanings in this Policy:
  - a) *“Individuals”* – All categories of membership defined in the CCPSA bylaws, as well as all individuals employed by or engaged in activities with the CCPSA including, but not limited to, employees, independent contractors, athletes, coaches, performance partners/sport assistants, officials, volunteers, managers, administrators, committee members, and directors and officers of the CCPSA
  - a) *“Days”* – Days including weekends and holidays
  - b) *“PSO”* – Provincial/Territorial Sport Organizations recognized as partners by the CCPSA

### PURPOSE

2. The purpose of this Policy is to ensure universal enforcement and recognition of all disciplinary sanctions applied by the CCPSA or its PSOs.

### APPLICATION

3. This Policy applies to all individuals.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

4. The CCPSA and its PSOs will:
  - a) Recognize and respect the disciplinary sanctions imposed by either the CCPSA or a PSO
  - b) Enforce the disciplinary actions and sanctions imposed by either the CCPSA or a PSO
  - c) Provide a copy of any applicable disciplinary actions, sanctions and/or decisions, subject to any confidentiality or privacy considerations
  - d) Notify each other within seven (7) days of any disciplinary actions, sanctions and/or decisions
  - e) Notify each other within seven (7) days of any further action related to a sanction, including, but not limited to, an appeal decision
  - f) Update their governing documents to encompass the reciprocation as described herein

### APPEALS

5. Decisions made in accordance with this Policy are not appealable.
