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1. Competition Overview

*For clarity, the 24-hour clock is used in this document (ex: 21h00 = 9:00 pm) and all times are in EST (Eastern Standard Time).

1.1 Eligibility Criteria

All participants must be members in good standing of an organization that is a provincial partner of the Canadian Cerebral Palsy Sports Association. Athletes must be 15 years of age before January 1st, 2024.

1.2 Code of Conduct

The Canadian Cerebral Palsy Sports Association Code of Conduct will be the standard for all participants.

1.3 Rules

This tournament will be conducted following the <u>2022-2024 BISFed International Boccia</u> <u>Rules v.2.2</u> The Technical Delegate shall resolve any technical issues not included in this document.

It is the responsibility of each province competing in the Canadian Boccia Championships to ensure that all competitors and technical personnel are familiar with the 2nd Edition Boccia Canada Classification Rules, the BISFed Boccia Classification Profiles (Part 13), BISFed Competition Manual 2022-2024 and the 2022-2024 BISFed International Boccia Rules v.2.2 (link above).

1.4 Event Categories

Individual: BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4, BC5, Open

Team/Pairs: Team BC1/2, Pairs BC3, and Pairs BC4/5/Open

The OPEN category is reserved for athletes with an impairment that do not meet criteria for categories BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4 or BC5.

1.5 Maximum Number of Athletes

Wild Card athletes were accepted at the decision of the Technical Delegate.

1.6 Team / Pair Composition

New:

- Team / Pair rosters were required to be submitted in advance (September 30th for provincial Teams/ Pairs; October 31st for Wild Card Teams/ Pairs)
- No substitutes in Team / Pairs
- Wild Card athletes or athletes not named to their provincial Team / Pair roster could form Wild Card Teams / Pairs
- Provinces with enough registered athletes to field a second official team or pair could submit an additional Team/Pair roster

Acceptance of these additional Teams or Pairs was the decision of the Technical Delegate.

Team / Pair Roster forms were sent to the designated team lead for each province in advance. After provinces submitted their rosters, the Team / Pair roster form was sent directly to Wild Card athletes and athletes not already named on a provincial Team / Pair Roster so they had an opportunity to connect and make up a WC team / pair.

1.7 Team / Pair Roster Changes

No changes to the Team / Pair Rosters will be accepted, except in case of <u>injury</u>, <u>illness</u> or a change in classification.

In the case of injury, illness or a change in classification, a Wild Card athlete can replace an athlete on a provincial Team or Pair, prior to the start of the Team & Pairs event, and subject to a Wild Card team/pair not being broken-up.

Replacements are **only** permitted if an athlete cannot compete due to injury, illness or a change in classification.

All Team / Pair rosters (including any replacements due to injury, illness or a change in classification), must be confirmed in writing to the Technical Delegate by 12h00 (noon) on Friday, November 15th.

The Technical Meeting for Team / Pairs will be held on **Friday, November 15**th at the time and location identified in the schedule.

2. Communication of Schedule + Results

The **Team Leader/Wild Card Whatsapp group** will be used for communication with the team representatives of each province. Team representatives are responsible for relaying this information to the members of their delegation. Wild Card athletes and athletes without a Team Manager or Coach will be included directly in the WhatsApp group.

The Technical Delegate will create the WhatsApp group using the cell phone numbers provided through the registration process. It is the individual's responsibility to have WhatsApp installed on their phone.

The Competition Schedule and Results will be available throughout the competition via the Boccia Competition Management System (BCMS). The BCMS link will be shared via the event website and the WhatsApp group after classification assessments have been completed and the schedule is confirmed.

The competition schedule will also be reviewed with provinces in the Technical meeting.

A QR code for the schedule will be posted at the venue during the competition and will also be available online at www.bocciacanada.ca.

3. Competition Structure

The competition structure conforms to principles defined by World Boccia. For more information, please consult the <u>BISFed Competition Manual</u>. The competition structure will be explained in more detail during the technical meeting.

4. Classification

All athletes competing at the Canadian Boccia Championships must be classified. Classification will be conducted in accordance with the 2nd Edition Boccia Canada Classification Rules and the BISFed Classification Profiles (see Part 13).

Classification will take place at the RA Centre on Wednesday November 13th, 2024 following the schedule outlined in Section 8.

IMPORTANT: Athletes being classified must ensure the <u>medical diagnostic form</u> is completed and returned to <u>hbonas@bocciacanada.ca</u> 24 hours before arriving on site for classification. Failure to do so may result in the athlete not being able to compete.

All athletes scheduled for classification have been notified directly with details about the classification process and the items/personnel they need to bring with them.

In the event of an appeal, the process outlined in the 2nd Edition Boccia Canada Classification Rules (link above) will be followed.

If there are any changes in classification once games have started, the competition will continue as is and these changes will take effect <u>as soon as the games for that</u> event are finished.

Individual and Team/Pairs are considered separate events, so a classification change made once individual games have started will take effect at the beginning of the Team/Pairs event.

5. Equipment and Balls

5.1 Equipment Check

In keeping with the <u>update published on August 21st 2023</u>, athletes who play using a glove or splint need to bring it to equipment check for documentation by referees, but are not required to show proof of classifier approval.

Equipment check will take place at the venue, following the schedule in Section 8.

6. Training, Warm-up, and Call Room

If a registered Coach is not available to accompany an athlete into the warm-up area, call room or field of play, the athlete may designate **any registered Participant** as their **Coach Assistant** (per 2022-2024 BISFed International Boccia Rules v.2.2) <u>for that game</u>.

Registered participants named as Coach Assistants will temporarily have the same access privileges as a Coach (i.e. access to Warm-up area, Call Room, Coach position on Field of Play).

6.1 Training

Training for all provinces will be held on the warmup and competition courts at the RA Centre following the schedule in Section 8.

7. Athlete Bib Numbers

Bib numbers will be distributed at the first Technical Meeting.

NO replacement numbers will be available.

8.5 Competition Schedule

No preliminary competition schedule will be provided as the possibility of changes is too high. The competition schedule will be publicly available after the Technical Meeting on Wednesday, November 13th.

The Technical Delegate has contingency plans to accommodate classification changes without radical changes to the schedule.

However, if there are **multiple classification changes in multiple classes**, there is an <u>outside possibility</u> that additional adjustments may be needed, which could require additional adjustments to the Team/Pair event. We reserve the right to adjust Team/Pair play as needed.

This is not our goal as we strive for equity, but to fit the Team/Pairs event in the schedule, we may have to do one, or any combination of the options below:

- Add a line of individual games on Thursday and/or Friday
- Add a line of individual and/or Team/Pair games on Saturday
- Move the Team/Pair medal ceremony to the Closing Banquet
- Shorten Team/Pair practice time on Saturday
- Switch to 4-end team games

These options will only be exercised if absolutely necessary and only to the extent needed to fit the Team/Pair event in the schedule.
